1 <sup>st</sup> - 7 <sup>th</sup> March	<p><b>Reading-</b> Read to an adult on five different days this week and ask them to sign your reading records.</p> <p><b>Spellings-</b> Challenge words: every, everybody, even, great, break, steak, pretty, beautiful, after, fast</p> <p><b>Maths-</b> Login to TTRockstars for at least 10 minutes</p>
8 <sup>th</sup> - 14 <sup>th</sup> March	<p><b>Reading-</b> Read to an adult on five different days this week and ask them to sign your reading records.</p> <p><b>Spellings-</b> Words where '-er', '-est' and '-ed' are added to words ending in 'e': nicer, writer, baker, hoped, loved, largest, closest, looser, safer, simpler</p> <p><b>Maths-</b> Login to TTRockstars for at least 10 minutes</p>
15 <sup>th</sup> - 21 <sup>st</sup> March	<p><b>Reading-</b> Read to an adult on five different days this week and ask them to sign your reading records.</p> <p><b>Spellings-</b> Words where '-ing' is added to single syllable words: patting, humming, dropping, running, hopping, clapping, sitting, flipping, wrapping, slipping</p> <p><b>Maths-</b> Login to TTRockstars for at least 10 minutes</p>
22 <sup>nd</sup> - 28 <sup>th</sup> March	<p><b>Reading-</b> Read to an adult on five different days this week and ask them to sign your reading records.</p> <p><b>Spellings-</b> Words where '-ed' is added to single syllable words: patted, hummed, dropped, clapped, clipped, wrapped napped, ripped, drummed, dragged</p> <p><b>Maths-</b> Login to TTRockstars for at least 10 minutes</p>
29 <sup>th</sup> February - 4 <sup>th</sup> March	<p><b>Reading-</b> Read to an adult on five different days this week and ask them to sign your reading records.</p>

	<p><b>Spellings</b> Words where 'a' makes an /or/ sound before 'l' and 'll': all, ball, call, always, fall, small, also, bald, almost, already</p> <p><b>Maths</b> Login to TTRockstars for at least 10 minutes</p>
5 <sup>th</sup> - 11 <sup>th</sup> April	<p><b>Reading</b> Read to an adult on five different days this week and ask them to sign your reading record.</p> <p><b>Spellings</b> Words where 'o' makes an /u/ sound: other, mother, brother, nothing, cover, money, some, dozen, wonder, done</p> <p><b>Maths</b> Login to TTRockstars for at least 10 minutes</p>
12 <sup>th</sup> - 18 <sup>th</sup> April	<p><b>Reading</b> Read to an adult on five different days this week and ask them to sign your reading record.</p> <p><b>Spellings</b> Challenge words: last, past, father, class, grass, pass, plant, path, bath, rather</p> <p><b>Maths</b> Login to TTRockstars for at least 10 minutes</p>

Optional Activities	<p>In History, we're learning all about The Great Fire of London. In a shoebox, create your own, mini Puddling Lane model. Don't forget to include Thomas Farriner's bakery (where the fire started). Think about how London would've looked like in 1666 and try to make it as realistic as possible.</p> <p>In Science, we're learning all about 'Plants'.
