We run a School Bank in Partnership with City Plymouth Credit Union Ltd. We believe that this is a wonderful way for children to gain a good understanding of money and the importance of saving weekly, an ideal way to help save towards presents and holidays.

The School Bank is open to all children and adults and membership is free to children, there is a £2 non-refundable admin fee for adults. Savers will have a bank book with its unique Credit Union number, which we keep safe at the school to record all the money going in and out of accounts, all money is banked and sent to the Plymouth Credit Union.

There is a small dividend paid if your child saves every week during the term.

The School Bank is open every week during the term on Tuesday afternoons straight after school 3.30pm to 3.50pm in the Upper Hall.

If you would like your child/ren or yourself to open an account (2 forms of ID needed for adults) please see Jenn for the application forms.

Should you wish to access your money when the School Bank is closed you can visit the Credit union central office (Tel 201329 for details). The City of Plymouth Credit Union is a not-for-profit organisation. It is strictly regulated by the Financial Services Authority (FSA).
