
Moths to a Flame Project

A moth trap was set up in the grounds overnight and in the morning, the children went out to see which moths they had caught. These were brought into school in observation containers for the children to sketch and identify. Once we had done that, they were carefully released back into the wild.

We've also recycled milk bottles, to create our own moths. These are on display in school (and look amazing), but they will be travelling up to Scotland later in the year, to be displayed at COP26.

During the week, we've also created an augmented reality moth - where we saw our colouring come to life, researched moths and written about them, as well as recording messages of hope for the environment, which will be played alongside the art installation.

It's been a fantastic week and the children have been incredible with their enthusiasm and efforts.
