Dear Parents and Carers

We have a number of new children starting in school at the moment, and over the next few weeks, and I am so proud of the way your children help any new children at Widewell feel really welcome and look after them as they are settling in. This is probably why it's so difficult to choose a winner for the Friendship Cup each week! Today, you should also receive a letter about the need for your children to have a healthy lunch each day. I have included links to ideas for healthy lunchboxes but would also like to remind you that all of the infant children should be having their free school dinner each day and that the meals are nutritionally balanced and we have a wide range of options every day: a meat or fish meal; a vegetarian meal: jacket potatoes with a variety of toppings; and wraps with a variety of fillings, as well as the deli bar which has a wide choice of salad ingredients prepared freshly every day. I would encourage you to sign your child up for a school dinner as often as possible and you will find that they eat a lot more than they might lead you to believe they will at home. We encourage but don't force children to eat their food and will find an alternative if they've tried something new but don't like it. Please read the letter carefully because there is a reminder about items that are not allowed in lunchboxes as there have been too many unhealthy items spotted over the past few weeks, including sweets, Crunchie bars and chocolate spread sandwiches with chocolate biscuits. We will be looking out for, and rewarding, healthy options each week with a new trophy for the classes to win. 
Earrings
