Home Learning Guide for Parents and Carers

Do:

- Find time to talk about your child's learning with them. Discuss what they have done and the books they are reading.
- Take pride in their learning and be proud of their work. Praise your child for working hard and trying their best.
- Encourage your child to complete the work to the best of their ability.
- Ensure that your child sets enough time aside to complete their activities so they are not rushing their work.
- Set aside a quiet place where there are no distractions and ensure that your child has a table to sit at.
- Contact your child's class teacher if there are any problems with the learning.
- Reward your child for good effort.
- Have breaks often. Allow your child to move around and have a snack and a drink if they are struggling to stay on task.

Please do not:

- Complete your child's work for them.
- Allow your child to get stressed or worried about their home learning.
- Get stressed or worried yourself about your child's home learning (contact the class teacher if you have questions or concerns).
- Allow your child to rush their learning.
