Year 4 are practising their class assembly on their topic; The Tropical Rainforest. Due to be recorded and uploaded to YouTube, this Friday.





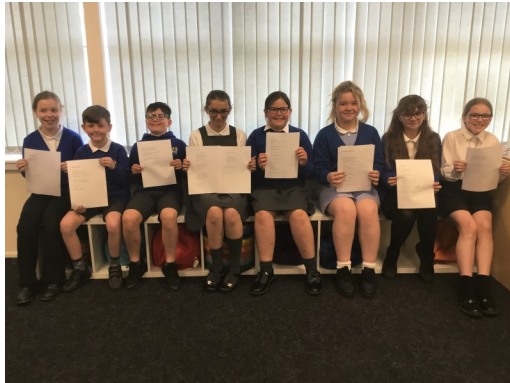


Nursery have been taking as much of their learning outside as they can.
