

Are Dragons Real?

English

Year 1 will continue using Read Write Inc to increase their phonic knowledge and develop their writing.

Year 2 will be continuing to write for different purposes, including narratives and letters.

DT

Children will be designing and making their own dragon sock puppet.

History

Children will be looking at stories of dragons, in particular the story of St George slaying the dragon. They will be comparing royal weddings by using clues from pictures as well as learning about monarchs.

Art

Year 1 will be creating a dragon island using different types of paper. Year 2 will be looking at using different resources to create daffodil art work.

PE

This term's PE lessons will focus on competitive activities where the children will learn show control and accuracy with some the basic skills associated with net or ball games.

Computing

The children will be using the computers to draw pictures for their own eBooks.

They will also continue to learn how to use the internet safely.

Science

We will be growing our own plants and designing our own investigation to find out if plants really do need water, heat and light to grow. The children will learn the main parts of a plant and begin to understand what they do. They will also be learning to recognise common plants and trees.

Maths

The children will be consolidating their understanding of place value this term and addition and subtraction. They will begin to look at measures, including length, weight and time.

RE

Year 1 will be learning about what it means to belong, forgive and how Christians show that they belong.

Year 2 will be comparing celebrations across different religions.
