

Reading, Spelling and Handwriting

- Reading is the most important thing your child will learn to do. We change reading scheme books and library books on a Monday. If your child finishes the reading scheme book quickly, they can change it earlier. Please comment in the reading records and sign each week.
- They need to choose a book to use in their reading journals.
- Spellings come home every Friday. Please help your child to learn them (particularly the rule).
- We use cursive handwriting at Widewell. It is very important that your child learns to join their handwriting.
- This is cursive handwriting!

What does your child need?

- Reading record and books daily
- Named PE kit on Monday and Wednesday (useful to leave in school all week)
- Named water bottle (plain water only please)
- Coat (waterproof)
- Named pencil case and pencils (not essential)
- Homework on a Friday
- Fruit money/fruit snack if required

PE – School PE kit must be worn, hair tied back and earrings removed

Homework – Reading, Spelling & Maths should be completed each week and signed homework cards and reading records handed in. No homework = no golden time!

How to Support your Child with Maths and English Skills

- Listen to them read. Chat to them about their books. Look at their reading journals and sign their reading records.
- Love books and reading (this encourages your child to love it too!)
- Sit with them and chat about their Times Tables Rockstars activities. MyMaths logins will be available soon.
- Maths (Mrs Holder) and Reading (Mrs Kerr) meetings for parents will take place this term.
- Please see me at any time if there is any confusion over strategies your child is learning.
